Having Fun



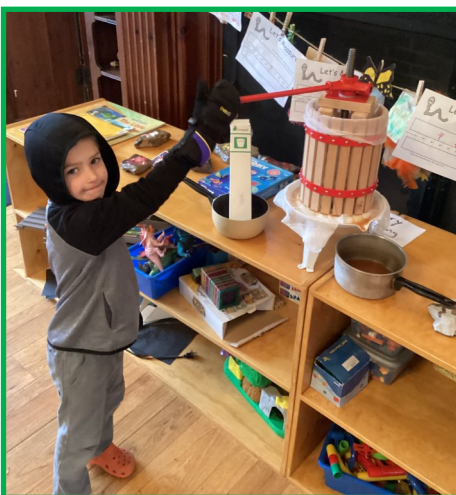
