We will be celebrating Dr. Seuss week February 27– March 3. We invite students to participate in the following themes:



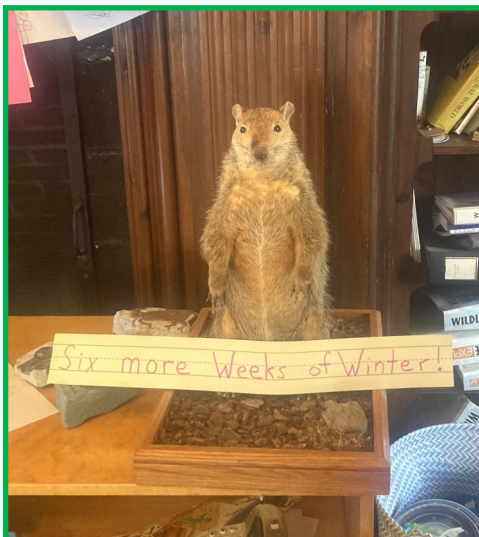
Monday: Crazy hair/silly socks!
